- Fire watchers have been assigned to the area and know how to give alarm (locate fire alarm pull stations).
- Ample extinguishing equipment for immediate use has been provided.
- All cutting & welding equipment was found to be in good repair.
- Warning signs have been posted as needed OUTSIDE of the Hot Work operational area
